

CLPX Contact Information, February 15-March 1 2002 (February Field Campaign)

In the event that you need to contact CLPX personnel during the field campaign, bear in mind that the experiment schedule may shift due to weather delays or other contingencies. The ground component of the CLPX will be based in three areas: Fraser CO, Walden CO, and Steamboat Springs CO. The aircraft component will be based in Colorado Springs, CO (NASA DC-8) and in Westminster, CO (NOAA AC690).

Feb 15 (day):

En route to Colorado. Leave voicemail at Office number or send email. I'll check Voicemail at mid-day and both Voicemail and Email in the evening.

Feb 15 (evening) to Feb 20 (evening):

Fraser Study Area. Use the international mobile number for immediate contact, otherwise use the Fraser Operations Base (day) or Fraser Lodging (evenings through Feb 19).

Feb 20 (evening) to Feb 22 (evening):

North Park Study Area. Use the international mobile number for immediate contact, otherwise use the Walden Lodging number above through the afternoon of Feb 22.

Feb 22 (evening) to Feb 25 (evening):

Rabbit Ears Study Area. Use the international mobile number for immediate contact, otherwise use the Rabbit Ears Lodging number above through the afternoon of Feb 25.

Feb 25 (evening) to Mar 1 (morning):

Fraser Operations Base. Use the international mobile number for immediate contact, otherwise use the Fraser Operations Base (day or evenings).

Mar 1 (day):

Return to Minnesota. Leave voicemail at Office number or send email. I'll check both Voicemail and Email in the evening.
